Funding is being sought for a new Basket Swing.

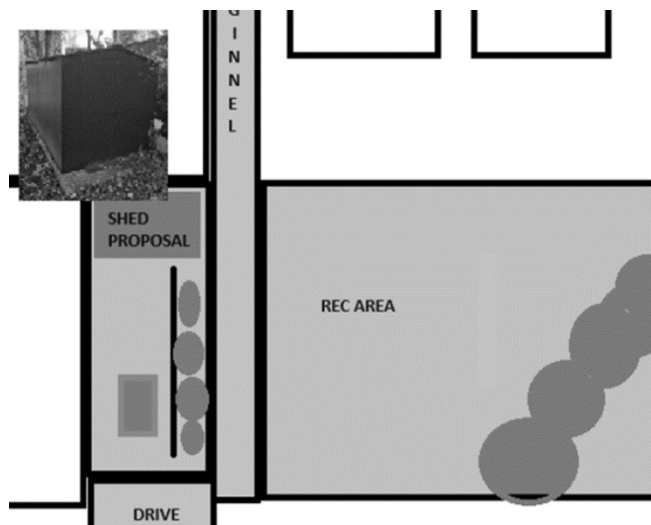

The Parish Council would also like any ideas and suggestions for use of the Old Telephone Box on Turnshaw Road – please email the clerk (as above!)

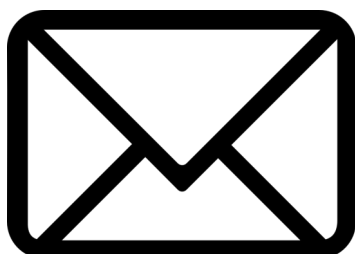
Update from the Millenium Trust
